Building a Professional Qualification

As mentioned in the April newsletter, an AiBEC committee is working on the development of a professional qualification for insurance claims consultants. We are pleased to report that we have commenced discussions with ANZIIF to integrate relevant education units from ANZIIF, ATTAR, and Pointsbuild into a cohesive course offering. We anticipate sharing further details on this initiative soon, which will be a key component of AiBEC's value to members and the broader insurance consultancy sector.

Supporting the Community

In a promising new initiative, AiBEC has begun early-stage discussions with the Financial Rights Legal Centre to explore a pro bono support program. This would enable AiBEC members and allied supporters to assist vulnerable insurance claimants. Both organisations have expressed strong early interest, and we look forward to developing this initiative further as a meaningful way to give back to the community.

Technical Education & Engagement

On 29 May, Berkay Dincel of Dincel Structural Walling presented a well-received webinar hosted by AiBEC. Looking ahead, two additional webinars are scheduled featuring Don Considine from ATTAR and Deborah Lockhart from RHM Consultants. These sessions will focus on key technical topics relevant to our members.

Additionally, we plan to form an ongoing Technical Committee comprised of members and allied supporters. This group will be tasked with identifying and investigating pressing issues of interest within the industry.



Recently we received a letter of introduction and small gift from the Nepal Insurance Surveyors Association, presented by their member Pratik Karki *(see above)*. They expressed a desire to work with AiBEC in the future and we hope this is the first of many overseas collaborations.
